TEACHING OBJECTIVE: I CAN WORSHIP GOD

BIBLICAL TEXT: READ TOGETHER PSALM 145:3 (NIV)

1. Read Psalm 145:3 (NIV)

“Great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; His greatness no one can fathom.”

2. In which testament is this book of the bible found?

Answer: Old

3. Who wrote this book of the Bible?

Answer: Mostly King David and some other writers

4. What does it mean to worship God?

Answer: It means to tell God about how great He is and to thank Him for all that He does.

5. Is worship a choice or a feeling?

Answer: Worship is a choice. We might not feel like worshipping, but we need to let God know how much we appreciate Him.

6. We should worship with all our _____?

Answer: Heart

7. What does it mean to worship with all our heart?

Answer: It means that we should focus on worship God and not get distracted.

8. When we worship God we should _____ Him to come?

Answer: Expect

9. What does it mean to expect God to come?

Answer: We should worship God as if He in the room. He is always with us, but sometimes we forget.

10. Do we have to wait until church to worship God?

Answer: No, we can worship Him at any time or anywhere.
