Packing List

Students will be required to wear their camp t-shirt and bring a backpack with them each day for camp. It will only need the following items:

- One extra change of clothes
- Towel
- Swimsuit (girls – modest two piece only)
- Bag for wet or dirty clothes
- Refillable water bottle
- Spray sunscreen
- Bible and pen (third and fourth graders only)

** Please remember to have girls put their bathing suit on under their clothes. Then, if she wants to change after water activities, pack her a pair of under garments. For the boys, they can wear their swim trunks to camp if they want, and after water activities they can change. Remember to pack dry shorts and undergarments. Label all clothing!

Medications

All prescription medications must be turned in to the nurse at registration on the first day. Our nurses are certified. Each nurse will make sure the students in his/her group take their medication.
