RESPONSIBILITIES

- Wearing appropriate clothing and protective gear.
- Being on time to your project site or communicating with your project leader if you are going to be late.
- Representing Christ and the Church as you serve and love those in need.
- Getting a Serve Day T-shirt or picking up supplies per your leader's instructions. You can find everything in Classroom A in the new part of the church. The room will be open beginning June 27 and continue to be open until Serve Day. If there is a class in the room, please don't disturb them.

SIGN UP BY JULY 20

To view all available SERVE DAY projects, simply go to MYVFC.INFO and click on the red Serve Day image. From there, please follow the steps below:

- Scroll down to the JOIN A PROJECT section and click on the JOIN A PROJECT button.
- Use the available filter options to find your perfect project (hint: be sure to note the start and end time so you can arrive on time).
- Select the project, click SIGN UP, fill out your contact information, and hit SUBMIT to officially join.
- You'll receive an email letting you know you successfully joined the project. Also, expect your project leader to reach out to you as well.
- Mark your calendar for July 24. Include a few notes about your project like its name, location, and time.
- If you have multiple people that you would like to register, please register each one individually.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

COMMUNICATING WITH YOUR TEAM

To communicate with your leader, go to MYVFC.INFO, open the site menu in the top-right corner, and click the MY VICTORY ACCOUNT button. Log in to your account and then click SERVE > MY SERVING in the main menu. You'll then be able to access your Serve Day project group and view all the members on your team, including your leader. At this point you could:

- Record their email and send them a message from your personal email address (Gmail, Yahoo, etc.).
- Record their phone number and send them a text message.

Whichever method you choose, just make sure you communicate the same way consistently and to an appropriate amount. Get your project leader excited but not annoyed.

PROJECT SAFETY

Serve Day is an amazing opportunity to make an impact, but that doesn't mean it comes without risk. Please take every reasonable step you can to ensure the safety of yourself, your team, and anyone hosting your project. Some suggestions include:

- Share your emergency contact and allergy information with your leader prior to starting any work. Oh yeah! And have a phone that works and is charged.
- Make sure you drink enough water and take time for sufficient breaks.
- Ensure all tools are safe for use and ask for permission to use them.
- Make sure you are dressed appropriately and use proper safety gear when necessary.
- Try to work in groups. This keeps you safe and ensures awareness of any injuries.

If an injury or an emergency does arise, stay calm. Have someone else take over your responsibilities, alert your leader, and tend to the person in need. Provide first aid, ask for a volunteer with medical experience for help, or call 911 if the situation is serious enough.

BAD WEATHER PLANS

Serve Day has no rain date, which means we're serving our community rain or shine. Your project leader will communicate any change in plans due to weather.
