CLASS NAME AND DETAILS	DATES
OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY I, II, III These classes will comprise all three fall months to give us sufficient time to examine all 39 books of the Old Testament. We will study the general theme and content of each book addressed. Our goals for these classes are to gain a better understanding of the leading characters of the Old Testament as well as their roles in preparing us to better understand the New Testament. LIVING BY THE LAW OF THE COVENANT The law of love is the law of the New Covenant. Jesus said that because lawlessness will abound in the last days before His return that the love of many will wax cold. It is necessary to remind ourselves, as believers, that the only way to walk in faith and healing and to live an overcoming life of victory is to stay under the protective umbrella of God's grace by keeping ourselves in the love of God (Jude 21). This class will help us to understand just how to do that in these dark times of the last days before the return of Christ.	Feb. 2, 9, 16, 23
JESUS CHRIST: PROPHET, PRIEST, KING The roles of prophet, priest, and king are primary leadership roles described in the Old Testament. When Jesus came to the earth, He fulfilled all three of these leadership roles. We will study the ministry of Jesus as Prophet, Priest, and King as laid out in Psalms 22, 23, and 24. Psalm 22 is a description of the early ministry of Jesus as prophet, detailing the suffering He would endure to secure our redemption. Psalm 23 is a description of Jesus' present-day ministry as our Great High Priest. Psalm 24 is a description of Jesus' future ministry as King over all the earth during the Millennial Reign of Christ.	March 2, 9, 16, 23
CONFORMED TO THE IMAGE OF CHRIST The Bible teaches us that believers are to be conformed to the image of Christ (Rom. 8:28-30). We will discover in this class what it means to be called, predestined, justified, and glorified, as born-again believers in Christ. We will learn that all believers must grow in grace and daily allow the Holy Spirit to mold us into all that we are ordained to become in Christ. Romans 8:28-30 explains this process of spiritual development. <i>"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover, whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified."</i> (Rom. 8:28-30 KJV).
